Financial Instruments EIB Project loans, intermediated loans Project loans finance projects promoted by private and public sector companies or entities, or PPPs EIB lends to projects for which total investment cost exceeds EUR 25 million EIB makes loans to local banks and other intermediaries which subsequently “on-lend”
